War is senseless and useless but returning ex-servicemen to Cape Town from World War II decided to make something useful and try to make sense out of the horrors they had experienced.

Instead of an inanimate stone memorial they dedicated their lives to building a lifesaving hospital for children.

And so the Red Cross Childrens Hospital was born.

However, because it was their memorial to those friends and comrades who had died fighting alongside them it was decided that the name should be:
